### **Status of C-4**

**Bill C-4 was not debated on Tuesday, November 1, and is not on the Projected Order of Business for Wednesday, November 2.** On Tuesday, the only immigration-related debate was a question raised by Don Davies about government allocation of funding to immigrant settlement services across the country, broken down by province, municipality, etc. – an answer for which was tabled by the government as a Sessional Paper. Today, party caucuses meet in the morning, and afternoon debate will be taken up by C-20, the *Fair Representation Act*. This is another among the government's bills that is included in their ambitious legislative agenda. The key issue in this bill is the addition of seats from Ontario, Alberta and BC in the House of Commons to more fairly represent population distribution. **It remains to be seen when C-4 will come up for debate again, but at this point it is highly unlikely that it would go to a vote before the break next week.**
