### **Status of C-4**

**Bill C-4 is not on the order paper for Tuesday, November 15, and was not debated on Monday, November 14.** On Monday, the only immigration-related issue was a question raised by Liberal MP Joyce Murray about changes to the live-in caregiver program, including access to permanent residency and the availability of the program to new applicants. Other than this question, no immigration or refugee issues were raised. Today, the House will debate C-13, the *Keeping Canada's Economy and Jobs Growing Act*, at Report Stage – at which time the bill returns from Committee, and any amendments are voted on. For C-13, the Finance Committee did not amend the bill, so it should move swiftly through to Third Reading. C-13 is one of the key bills that the government has indicated it wants to see passed as soon as possible. **There is still no indication of when C-4 may come up for debate again.**
