Status of C-4

Bill C-4 was not debated on Monday, November 21, and is not on the Projected Order of Business for today, Tuesday, November 22. Monday, there was no debate of issues relating to immigration or refugees. Today, the House will debate C-7, the *Senate Reform Act*, C-11, the *Copyright Modernization Act*, and may also debate C-14, the Improving Trade Within Canada Act, time permitting. C-13, the *Keeping Canada's Economy and Jobs Growing Act*, was passed at Third Reading last night, meaning that one of the government's top priority bills has now been sent to the Senate for consideration. In the Public Safety and National Security Committee, Bill C-19, *An Act to amend the Criminal Code and the Firearms Act* will be studied again today. **It remains to be seen when C-4 will be up for debate in the House again.**
