**Status of C-4**

**Bill C-4 is was not debated on Monday, October 17, and is not on the Projected Order of Business for Tuesday, October 18.** Despite C-4 being on the Projected Order of Business for Monday, debate on C-13, the *Keeping Canada's Economy and Jobs Growing Act*, continued for the duration of time allotted and left no opportunity for C-4 to be debated. Further, C-4 and its related issues were not discussed at any other point during debate yesterday. Today, two other government bills, C-11, *The Copyright Modernization Act*, and C-7, *The Senate Reform Act*, will be debated. It remains to be seen when C-4 will next be debated. Meanwhile, the House of Commons Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security continues its study on Drugs and Alcohol in Prisons.

Finally, it is worth noting that the NDP undertook a Shadow Cabinet shuffle over the weekend. Opposition leader Nycole Turmel changed several MPs' portfolios in order to remove any NDP leadership candidates from their critic roles until a new party leader is chosen in March. **No changes were made to the Public Safety or Citizenship and Immigration critics.**
