Status of C-4

Bill C-4 was not debated on Tuesday, October 18, and is not on the Projected Order of Business for Wednesday, October 19. Yesterday, two other government bills, C-11, *The Copyright Modernization Act*, and C-7, *The Senate Reform Act*, were debated. Today, C-18, the *Marketing Freedom for Grain Farmers Act*, is the only government bill on the Projected Order of Business. It is worth noting that Wednesdays have less time for debate – roughly half that of Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. This is due to the fact that Wednesday mornings are reserved for caucus meetings, during which each party's Members of Parliament and Senators gather discuss, in private, matters of parliamentary concern, constituency issues, and strategy. It remains to be seen when C-4 will be debated again.
