Status of C-4

Given that it was an Opposition Day, for which opposition parties are given the prerogative to set the agenda, **Bill C-4 was not debated on Tuesday**. Further, C-4 was not mentioned during Question Period or any other time during the day. The only immigration-related issue to be brought up was during Adjournment Proceedings – a 30-minute time period allotted at the end of the day for MPs to raise questions – and concerned the PEI provincial nominee program that has come under fire for corruption lately. **C-4 is not on the Projected Order of business for today, but may well be debated tomorrow, Thursday**. If, however, by the end of the day Thursday debate has not concluded and a vote has not been held, the vote on C-4 at Second Reading will have to wait until after the Thanksgiving break week (October 17th at the earliest). Normally, votes called on a Friday, or called on a Thursday but deferred to Friday, are then deferred to the end of business on the next sitting day – usually a Monday – which in this case would be after the break week.
